



DPS HONG KONG MANAGING DIRECTOR AWARDED MAJOR HONOUR

On the 15th November 2006, DPS Environmental Technologies Ltd Managing Director, Kam Wong, was amongst 28 citizens awarded the title of "Guangzhou Honorary Citizen" by the Guangzhou Municipal Government (PR China) in front of an audience of over 600. This is the highest title offered by the city to overseas Chinese, foreigners and compatriots from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan, and in the last 20 years only 345 people have earned the award.

The group was the 12th to be commended for their contributions to the city's economic and social development, involving investments totalling RMB 265 billion yuan (approximately £17.5bn), and donations of RMB 358 million yuan (approximately £24m).

This is a tremendous achievement and accolade for Kam, whose indomitable enthusiasm and work rate has fostered strong relations and links between Guangzhou and Bristol, as Chairman of the Bristol-China Partnership.

These traits have also been used to great effect for DPS Environmental Technologies Ltd in developing the awareness and capability of the DPS brand in Hong Kong and China. This has resulted in not only an increasing presence in the oil and gas industry, but also the development of a water recycling module set to be launched in 2007.
